## Supplies your child needs to bring with them the first week of school:

- A  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch binder with pockets inside, any color.
- A package of glue sticks
- -1 bottle of Elmer's glue (4 oz.)
- 1 package of Clorox or Lysol disinfecting wipes
- A pack of 4 dry erase markers (no yellow please!)
- 1 pack of thick washable markers
- -1 pack of thin washable markers
- 1 box of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 1 pack of #2 pencils (pre-sharpened are always helpful!)
- 1 box of tissues
- -1 highlighter

- Headphones in a Ziploc baggie labeled with your child's name for individual use on the computers
